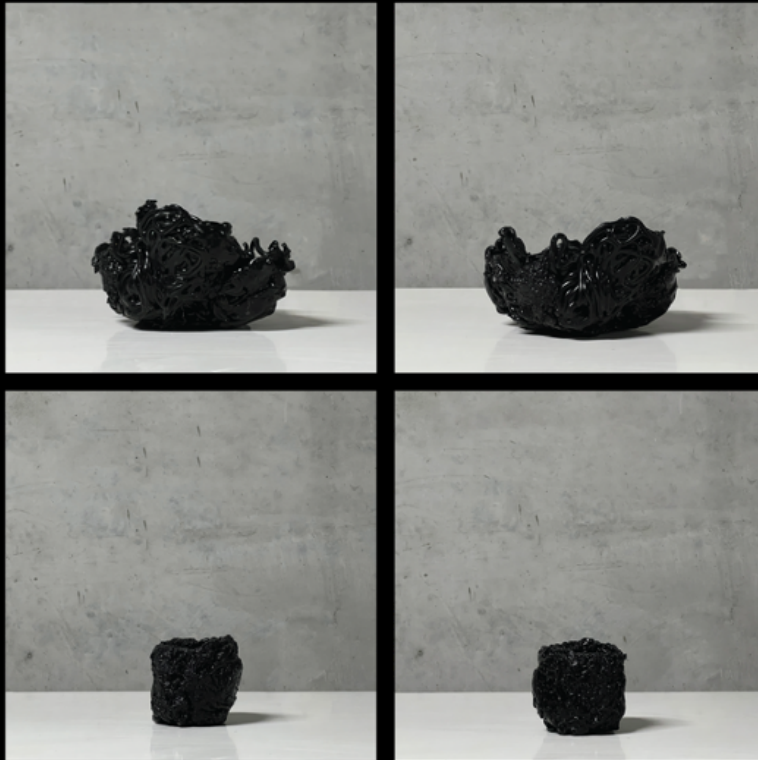
## Revolutionizing Plastic Perception

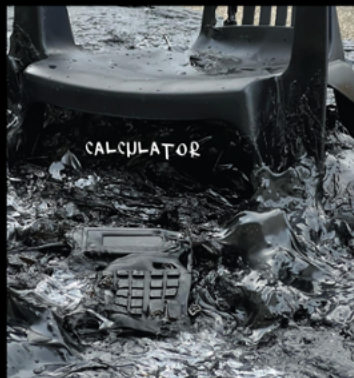
